# NORTHAMPTON COUNTY DOG and CAT Vaccination Schedule 2015

**Clinic Fee - NO CHARGE**  
**Out Of County Residents - \$3.00**

N.C. State law requires all dogs and cats, once they reach the age of 4 months to be vaccinated for Rabies and to wear Rabies Tags at all times.

Regardless of dog's or cat's age, first vaccination is good for 1 year only. All subsequent vaccinations thereafter are good for 3 years. All unclaimed or unwanted dogs may be turned over to the Rabies Control Officer at the Clinics. Dogs or cats vaccinated after Clinic: Will Require A Fee.

*\*\*A Dog and cat quarantine has been adopted by the County Commissioners for the month of May 2015. All dogs and cats shall be restrained either by penning or leashed. Dogs and cats loose shall be picked up and / or if necessary destroyed.*

**G.S. 130A - 185.**

Vaccination of All Dogs and Cats.  
-(a) The owner of every dog and cat over four months of age shall have the animal vaccinated against rabies. The time or times of vaccination shall be established by the Commission. Rabies vaccine shall be administered only by a licensed veterinarian or by a certified rabies vaccinator.
